

PRODUCTIVITY CHALLENGES

When this project began, hard copy personal files were commonplace within the organisation, making document searches challenging and time-consuming for the Human Resource (HR) department. Whenever letters were issued to staff, the HR department had to manually file a copy in each employee's personal folder for the purpose of archiving. This triggered the need for a secure central document repository that would enable the HR department to seamlessly and effortlessly share, manage and archive employee information.
